

Kaua'i Government Employees Federal Credit Union (KGEFCU) hosted a webinar on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 introducing Kauai's 2021 Coronavirus Rental and Utility Assistance. Thank you to the more than 130 residents who watched and participated in the webinar and asked some wonderful questions which have been consolidated and will be added to the www.kauairenthelp.com FAQ page soon.

Wednesday's recorded webinar is now available for viewing on the website. Applications to the program is anticipated to open early May. An announcement will be made when a firm date is confirmed.

We are putting together a calendar of outreach informational meetings to help prepare for when the application process begins. We will also have a few satellite locations scheduled around the island. This calendar will be forthcoming and posted on the website. Persons without internet access or a computer are encouraged to visit one of the satellite program locations around Kaua'i or see your local library times, availability, and guidelines below for when you may use the computers there once the program launches.

If you need an auxiliary aid/service or other accommodation due to a disability, contact KGEFCU at rent@kgefco.org as soon as possible. Please include "ADA" in the subject line of the email. Requests made as early as possible will allow adequate time to fulfill your request. Upon request, this notice is available in alternate formats such as large print, Braille, or electronic copy.

Eligible applicants may receive up to \$3,500 per month for rent and no cap per month for qualifying utilities in arrears. Information is required from both tenants and landlords in order for an application to be completed and qualify for the program. Cooperation from both parties is greatly appreciated.

Eligibility:

To qualify for rent and/ or utility assistance when applications open in May, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Kaua'i County resident;
- Be at least 18 years old;
- Be a renter; and
- Have lost income due to the COVID-19 pandemic and have an annual gross household income at or below 80% of the area median income (AMI) for the number of members in their household. For reference, the following illustrates the 80% AMI for various household sizes:

1 person	\$ 57,100
2 persons	\$ 65,250
3 persons	\$ 73,400
4 persons	\$ 81,550
5 persons	\$ 88,100
6 persons	\$ 94,600
7 persons	\$ 101,150
8+ persons	\$ 107,650

Households with income of no more than 50% percent of the AMI or in which one or more household member(s) is unemployed and has been unemployed for 90 days will be prioritized.

Funding will be limited to households' primary residence of Kaua'i and Ni'ihau. Households will be limited to 12 months of total grant assistance.
